SOME EXTRA IDEAS FOR SPARKS

1. Ruth followed Naomi wherever she went. She was loyal and stuck by her all the time.
Make up a game of follow the leader. How close can you stick to the leader and how carefully can you follow the pathway they are making?



2. REFLECTIONS!

Ruth followed Naomi and we are following Jesus. To follow Him means to become more like Him. Play this game and then talk about how we can be like Jesus. Pray together.

One person tries to mimic the other person's actions as they stand face to face. You can try simple things like hand and leg movements, pulling faces, turning around. See how much you can be a true reflection!

3. MATCHY, MATCHY

Ruth and Naomi stuck together. Find some pairs of objects that go together (toothbrush and paste, sock and shoe, knife and fork), muddle them up and play a matching game.
